Just like in those events, the kids are placed onto a sheep in a real bucking chute. When the chute door opens, the sheep take off and riders hang on as long as they can. Every rider is given a participation belt buckle and earns a permanent ear-to-ear grin.

Kids must be between the ages of 4 to 7 years old and 50 pounds or less. The entry fee is \$40.00.

Parents must sign a Release of Liability & Rules Agreement, as well as provide proof of medical insurance for their child to participate. Helmets and protective vests are required and will be provided by the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo. Participation is limited to the first 24 correctly completed entries received by the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo.
