First Place: The first place Cowboy and Cowgirl will earn admission to the rodeo on one day of their choosing and a lap in the RAM truck in their winning western attire during that day's rodeo with the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo Queens.

Second Place: The second place Cowboy and Cowgirl will earn admission to one performance of the rodeo and a lap in the RAM truck during the rodeo in their winning western attire with the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo Queens.

RULES AND INFORMATION:

Please read thoroughly

- Must be between 3 and 6 years of age by the start of the 2022 Valley Center Stampede Rodeo and Memorial Festival.
- Must submit video and application via email by April 30, 2022.
- One boy and one girl will be selected for first place, and one additional boy and one additional girl will be selected for second place.
- Video must be less than 30 sec and say name, age, and why they love the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo.
- Videos judged by committee on best western attire and cutest introduction/reason they love rodeo.
- Videos may be posted to the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo & Memorial Festival social media accounts. Submission of video to competition is consent for the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo and Memorial Festival to utilize video in social media posts and other promotional outlets. Video will not be used for personal profit.
- ALL winners must be checked-in by parent/guardian PRIOR to the rodeo performance they are signed up for:
 - Friday, May 27, 2022 Check-in is between 5:00 5:30 p.m.
 - Saturday, May 28, 2022 Check-in is between 12:00-12:30 p.m.
- Winners will be given a wristband upon checking in. Participants MUST wear the designated wristband to participate.
- The Rodeo Announcer will announce that the Best Little Cowboy/Cowgirl needs to meet at the gate 10 minutes prior to their ride in the truck. Parents/Guardians must listen for the announcement (based on the time given via the confirmation email) and bring their child to the gate at the appropriate time.

- Parents/Guardians are not allowed in the chute area or in the back. A rodeo personnel will escort your child to the truck, ride with them in the truck with the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo Queens, then return your child to you after the ride in the truck. A photo of the participant in the truck with the Rodeo Queens will be taken. They will be supervised by a rodeo committee member for the duration of their ride and during the escort there and back.
- Due to time constraints, each participant will only be given one shot at a ride in the truck. If they refuse, their ride will be forfeited, and they will <u>not</u> be able to ride in the truck on a different night.
- Riding in the back of the truck is inherently dangerous. However, the RAM driver is skilled and experienced at driving in arenas. An official RAM truck driver and/or commercial driver is required from the dealership and our rodeo to ensure the truck is driven properly and safely. The truck goes slow and the Rodeo Queens (ages 6-27) are able to stand and throw T-shirts comfortably while the truck moves.
- Entry confirmation will be emailed out to the parent or legal guardian listed on the entry form (email address must be provided). Official results will be emailed and posted to social media accounts.
- YOUR APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RECEIVED BY THE VALLEY CENTER STAMPEDE RODEO COMMITTEE:
 - Completed and signed Application and Liability Release
 - < 30 sec video answering prompts above</p>
 - Email confirmation response from parent or legal guardian to the rodeo committee agreeing to all rules listed above

Release of Liability & Agreement to Terms - Must be signed for entry to be accepted:

I, the undersigned, hereby release the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo, Inc., County of San Diego, and All In Pro Rodeos, LLC, their agents and employees, from any and all property damage and/or personal injury liability, which may occur from any cause, including neglect. I have entered my child of my own free will, and child is of sound mind and body, and is physically fit to complete the activity. I understand the inherent danger of rodeo competition and events. Further, I have read and agree to follow the Rules & Information. I understand that if I do not abide by the posted rules, my child will not be able to participate in the event.

I understand and give consent that the video I provide of my child may be shared on social media sites managed by and related to the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo and Memorial Festival. I understand the video can be freely shared and utilized for other promotional purposes.
